## KALYANAMASTU PATHAKAM



Andhra Pradesh Brahmin Welfare Corporation (APBWC) is announcing launch of "Kalyanamastu Pathakam" for the year 2019-20, in order to encourage Vedic Culture. Now a days most of the Brahmin girls are not willing to marry the Brahmin boys who are in the profession of *Pourohityam, Veda-Parayanam and Archakatam*. To encourage the girls marrying the boys who are getting their livelihood through Vaidikam, a onetime Financial Assistance of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy-Five Thousand only) will be granted.

This scheme is applicable to the Brahmin girls marrying a Brahmin boy living in Andhra Pradesh, whose livelihood comes from *Pourohityam, Veda Parayanam, Archakatvam*.

### Eligibility Norms:

- The applicant (Bride) should have completed 18 years of age at the time of marriage and the bridegroom should have completed 21 years.
- The Bride and her parents should belong to Brahmin community.
- Bride should be enrolled in the Praja Sadhikara Survey (PSS)
- The Bridegroom should be a Brahmin resident of Andhra Pradesh and his livelihood should come from *Pourohityam* or *Veda Parayanam* or *Archakatvam*.
- Bridegroom should not be a fulltime employee/professional in other professions or a fulltime Business man or Industrialist.

### **Application Procedure:**

- The bride should apply online ([www.andhrabrahmin.ap.gov.in](http://www.andhrabrahmin.ap.gov.in)) with relevant documents, 15 days before the marriage or within 30 days after marriage.
- The data entered will be validated with the data of Mee Seva, Praja Sadhikara Survey.

- Scrutiny, short listing and finalisation of applications will be done by the State Level Selection Committee (SLSC) of APBWC.
- The scheme amount will be transferred online directly to the Bride's Savings Bank account number provided in the application.
- APBWC reserves the right to cancel/withdraw or recover the benefit amount if any of the information provided by the bride or bridegroom is found to be not true.
